The Society for Terrorism Research (STR) and the Centre for Trust, Peace and Social Relations at Coventry University are delighted to announce that the 14th annual international STR conference will be held on September 8th and 9th, 2022, on the university's Coventry Campus. This conference will focus on the theme **The Future of Terrorism and Terrorism Research**.

Proposals for paper presentations, panel proposals and/or posters will be considered for inclusion in the programme if they are received by May 9th, 2022. We will notify everyone that submits on 16th May 2022 on whether their submission has been accepted.

In addition to showcasing new research on terrorism, the goal of this conference will be to consider what the future of terrorism and, indeed, terrorism research might look like by 2030.

The conference will seek to stimulate discussion around fundamental questions, including:

- How do we build meaningful and sustainable relationships between the research, policy and practice communities?
- How do we maximise impact from the research that is undertaken?
- How do we enhance innovation in terrorism research and harness expertise in other disciplines as well as researchers that may not have considered themselves to have a role in terrorism studies?
- How do we achieve this while continuing to address contemporary terrorism-related issues?

These questions cannot be answered by any one single topic and as such we welcome paper presentations, panel proposals and/or posters that cover any topic related to terrorism research.

All paper presentations abstracts, panel proposals and/or poster submissions should be submitted by the **9th May 2022**.
